PMI Global Best Chapter Award 2022

Project Management Institute (PMI) Kerala Chapter has been awarded The Global Best Chapter Award at the PMI Global Summit held at Las Vegas, USA, for its outstanding contribution to professional and community engagements. The PMI Chapter Awards program provides recognition of volunteer efforts



and acknowledgement of their contributions towards achieving the objectives of project management impact through professionalism, volunteering, and social support initiatives.

PMI Kerala Chapter has been serving the project management community for the past 19 years. PMI Kerala has won the global award in recognition of its flagship programs like organic farming, introducing project management concepts to school students and college student forums under the

Academic Outreach initiative, empowering women leadership, cross-continent professional development events, and assistance to Government organizations in developing project management practices.

Proud winners of the chapter awards in category two at the PMI Global Summit, PMI Kerala Chapter, is the pinnacle of determination, vision and innovation in the region. PMI Kerala has led by example and has achieved many milestones, be it the flagship PM Conference Waves, the Academic Conclave Wings, their empowering programs, social outreach programs, Whiz Talks, or contributing 15,000 hours to the Hours of Impact initiative. This led to the PMI South Asia region honouring PMI Kerala with the award for 'Fearless Vision 2022'.

Chapter marks record for PMI Student Membership in SA Region

Considering the success of the Academic Outreach program, the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter launched the PMI student membership program at Wings 2022. The PMI student membership program offers a special price for students to become PMI members. The program is being offered at a heavily discounted price of US\$12 plus taxes from the usual US\$32 plus taxes. It is valid for one-year membership to PMI and the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter. Students are given access to all resources at PMI as well as exclusive access to webinars, certification offers, and a huge network of project professionals across the world. PMI Kerala has set the record for the maximum number of student memberships, all of which are initiated and fostered by our multiple academic forums.

PMI Kerala Chapter 20th Anniversary

PMI Kerala Chapter kick started its 20th year celebrations. Dr Srini Srinivasan, PMI South Asia Regional MD joined the first meeting, a member family meet. Events and Conference

PMI South Asia Regional Conference - PMRC2022

The Project Management Regional Conference (#PMRC22) held on the 21st of May 2022, at Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala was a resounding success. A celebration of the project management profession which brought together hundreds of practitioners, chapter leaders and business professionals from around the region and served as common ground for the project management community to exchange information on best practices, latest trends, technology, and experience the thought provoking addresses by industry captains and leaders from across domains. It was a one of its kind hybrid events, where our tech worked seamlessly to provide an unforgettable happy experience to our virtual audience.

With eminent personalities as speakers, the event was well covered by media across the state and country. A book authored by Dr. Kiran Bedi was given to all participants. She attended in person for the event and gave a rousing speech session. The icing in the cake was she agreeing to take time to personally give her autograph in the book for the 300+ participants.

WINGS2022

The PMI Trivandrum Kerala Chapter hosted the fourth edition of the Academic Forum Conclave **WINGS2022** at Muthoot Institute of Technology, Kochi on 24 July 2022. The conclave is part of the Chapter's academic outreach program that aims to provide an opportunity for students of business schools and professional colleges, faculty members and researchers to meet and network with industry experts.

Initially, only students of the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter's academic forums were allowed to participate in the event. But now the conclave has extended invitations to students outside the academic forums. Rasmi V. Nair, conference director of the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter, gave the welcome address while President Jayakishore S. R. delivered the presidential address. This was followed by the inaugural address by Dr. B. Ashok, secretary, Agricultural Department, Government of Kerala, who captured the audience's attention with anecdotes from his life. Keynote speaker Joseph Korah, president and cofounder of Impactive, discussed significant facets of entrepreneurship and project management. A business quiz, which added a fun and competitive element, was hosted by Dileep Viswanathan, vice president of professional development. Four teams from various colleges took part in the quiz. Fayiz Muhammed S. and Sreehari K. S. from Muthoot Institute of Technology and Science took away the winner's trophy. Visukumar Gopal, PMI regional advisor for youth and social impact for the South Asia Region, spoke about how an effective résumé can create an impact on recruiters. Dr. Pradeep S., assistant vice president of NeST Digital, talked about the concept and methods of design thinking. The final keynote speaker was Santhosh C. Kurup, chief executive officer of ICT Academy of Kerala, who enlightened young professionals about employment opportunities in the state.

UDAAN2022

UDAAN 2022, a program initiated by PMI Kerala Chapter under PMI Education Foundation (inception in 2019) was officially inaugurated on 20 May 2022, by Jennifer Tharp, Chair- Board of directors Project Management Institute and Mr Kathiravan M Pethi, Guinness Record Holder & International Speech Contest Winner. The opening address was by Ms Tharp, and the closing was splendidly orchestrated by Mr Pethi with an introduction to public speaking. It was enthralling to watch the little ones interacting with Mr Pethi while they picked up on a few crucial life lessons.



In Sep 2022, as part of the UDAAN2022 initiative, Jayakishore S. R, president of the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter also visited the Krishnapuram Government school. Jayakishore talked to students about the importance of project management and fielded questions from them on various aspects. After a meaningful discussion, educational kits were distributed to more than 100 deserving students.

Currently UDAAN supports 150 children, who are with the orphanage at Saigramam, Anandanilayam: an orphanage native to Trivandrum and a school in Krishnapuram. Our chapter supports these children by providing educational kits, alongside minimal coaching sessions on English. In Mar 2023, 10 needy children of Krishnapuram school were provided with scholarships, sponsored by one of our chapter members.

Partnering with Dr. Kiran Bedi's India Vision Foundation

PMI Kerala Chapter, as part of UDAAN2022 partnered with Dr. Kiran Bedi's India Vision Foundation to sponsor children's education. India Vision Foundation aspires to mainstream and facilitate education for children of Incarcerated parents, ensure their holistic development through various interventions to assist them to accomplish their academic, socio-emotional needs, and save them from becoming a victim of their parental incarceration. The cost to sponsor a child for 1 year is INR16,000/-which include child's remedial education, learning material, uniform & clothing, examination fees, internet data pack, counselling etc Following an appeal by the Chapter for the goodwill of members to support us in this noble cause, we received donations to the tune of Rs. 32,000/- in multiples of INR 1000/-. and also additionally 3 members came forward to sponsor a child completely by donating INR 16,000/- each. In all, we paid to India Vision Foundation Rs. 80,000/- and sponsored a total of 5 children for a year. We also received 80G certificates for the Chapter and the 3 members for this donation.

Toastmasters International

PMI Kerala Chapter made history again!! The Chartering Ceremony of PMI Kerala Chapter Toastmasters Club was held on the 24th of April 2022, virtually to enable the global leaders of both PMI and Toastmasters International (TMI) to grace the occasion. This club has the unique distinction of being the first Toastmasters Club in the PMI SA Region with membership exclusively for the chapter members only. PMI Kerala Chapter is happy to have pioneered the initiative of collaboration between the two great organizations which will benefit the chapter members with oratorial and effective communication skills. At the event, the first office bearers took oath of office and assumed office.

Dr. Srini Srinivasan, Managing Director, PMI South Asia Region inaugurated the Club. Thanks to the support from DTM Gauri Seshadri-International Director, DTM Vanitha Rangarajan Jha- District Director, Arjun Sundar Raj - Club Growth Director, DTM Narayanan Mannian M - Program Quality Director, Minnie Mohan - Division G Director, Arathi Rajeswari - Area Director, TM Sruthi and TM Nandini. PMI Kerala Chapter wishes to place on record our appreciation to the PMI Lakeshore Chapter leaders for all their support and guidance on chartering a Toastmaster Club within PMI Chapter. It is the vision of PMI Kerala Chapter President, Jayakishore S R, who also is the current President of Trivandrum Toastmasters Club, backed by the support of chapter members that made this initiative a reality.

The PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter Toastmasters Club conducted its official oath-taking ceremony of new club officers on 14 August for the term 01 July 2022 to 30 June 2023. The officer installation was presided over by Area Director TM Mallika. After that, members met for the eighth session of the



Toastmasters Club. Toastmasters Club was launched in April 2022 as a collaboration between the chapter and Toastmasters International, a public speaking initiative worldwide. This collaboration was brought about to encourage more upcoming leaders to polish their public speaking and leadership skills. Membership for the chapter's Toastmaster Club is open with the only prerequisite of being a member of the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter.

During the year, the Club conducted 19 meetings and also participated in joint meetings with 2 other clubs in Trivandrum as well as demo sessions for college students. The Club conducted the first Annual Club contest on 5 Mar 2023 for Evaluation Contest and Table Topics Contest. The club nominated a member for the International Speech Contest also. The Table Topics contest was held only at Club level while the Evaluation Contest winner participated in the Area Level competition. Chapter thanks all the participants for the contests and congratulates TM Jayakishore, TM Prasad and TM Reshma for winning the Evaluation Contest and TM Jayakishore, TM Reshma and TM Sindhya for winning the Table Topics contest.

The Club is proud to announce that our members TM Prasad KS and TM Jayakishore SR won the 3rd prize at the Area Level Contest for the International Speech Contest and Evaluation Contest respectively. We are happy to announce that we have also got the formal approval from Toastmasters International to officially charter the Chapter's Kids Gavel Club.

WhizTalks - Beyond Borders - PMIK and PMILOC

The novel member speaker platform Whiz Talk of PMI Kerala Chapter has crossed borders!! The first Joint Whiz Talk by PMI Kerala in collaboration with the Singapore chapter was officially inaugurated on the 15th of March 2022. This collaboration gives an opportunity to members of both chapters to volunteer as speakers. The first speaker Mr. Karthik Ramamurthy, a Kerala Chapter member and a PMI global volunteer, on the topic "Eight Effective Techniques towards Project Success" was a resounding success. The vote of thanks was presented by Ms. Alicja Kocanda, the Vice President of PMI Singapore Chapter. This short half an hour session for members also offers 0.5 PDUs.

PMI Whiz Talk offers an excellent opportunity for professionals to share their knowledge and expertise with our membership base. Speakers will have the chance to reach out to a large audience of project managers and learn more about what our members are looking for in terms of professional development opportunities. PMI Kerala Chapter started the WhizTalks Session for 2023. The first session was in collaboration with PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter An amazing speaker Yemisi Iyilade presented the topic Principles of Growth for Project Leaders. There was a strong audience and excellent interaction. Insightful questions raised the bar for the next speaker.

Volunteer Engagement

Specific meetup sessions with Chapter leaders and volunteers helps in the bonding of new members with Chapter initiatives and certification training. New members showing interest in volunteering, will be guided with the help of successful global volunteers in the Chapter to apply for the opportunities published in the PMI VRMS portal. For Chapter and Regional events, members are encouraged to come forward to volunteer. Recognition of the volunteers at respective events, star volunteer badges in newsletters and in the social media platforms are major encouragements for new members to volunteer.

As soon the new Board was set up, a VRMS opportunity was created for recruiting the second line of leadership to support each portfolio, with criteria set as volunteering hours in previous 2 years and

- 150 hours of Professional Development sessions delivered and 108 PDUs generated.

Academic Outreach

Academic Forums were renewed in the new academic year, based on the new list of students in all colleges. In addition to the existing colleges, we have expanded our reach to a few exceptionally good colleges in Kerala.

Internships
