

□ Smartference – Monthly in-person event for chapter members to meet, learn and network

## **Member Benefits**

## Single Membership and its impact

In 2023, to address the large gap between PMI only members and PMI + Chapter members, PMI launched the Single Membership program in India. After 30 November 2023, the membership plan



for PMI members in India changed with one chapter membership mandatorily included with their PMI membership renewal. Hence, members in India will get to choose one of the 9 chapters in India to be added along with PMI membership. However, the earlier option for multiple chapter memberships is discontinued.

As PMI Kerala Chapter had many global members, with multiple chapter memberships, our leadership had predicted and informed our South Asia Chapter Engagement Team on possible impact to our membership count with the launch of Single Membership. Further, discontinuance of special rates for the PMI Student Membership, offered until Dec 2023 will also have an impact on our student membership.

Despite these, the board is proud to inform that our membership count of 790 as of 31 Mar 2023 had seen a rise up to 854 members in Aug 2023 and is currently at 721 members, with expiry of one year terms of few global and student memberships!



The first-year member engagement and volunteering with the Chapter were specifically tracked with constant feedback sought to ensure their membership value was realized. The monthly new member induction programs mostly held online have been very helpful in onboarding new members to our chapter fold and introducing them to the various volunteering opportunities posted by chapter in VEP and updating them on the latest chapter initiatives. Professional mentoring, by the expert mentors in the chapter, was given to the requested professionals to take their career to the next level.

## **Volunteer Engagement**

Kerala Chapter follows a **four-tiered volunteer model** for functioning, which has been quite effective. The elected Board of Directors forms Tier1. The Tier2 comprises Associate Vice Presidents (AVPs), who assist in identifying portfolio-wise programs/events. Lead volunteers as Tier3, team up to execute the programs, with the aid of Tier4 volunteers. The Tier2 to Tier4 volunteer team is **recruited** based on volunteer opportunities in VEP. For AVPs, specific criteria of minimum hours of prior volunteering experience in previous year is mandated, as they form the second level leadership. This 4 tier model not only supports the effective realization of the plans, but also defines a **volunteer growth plan** and creation of second level leadership.



VEP opportunities were created for recruiting the second line of leadership to support each portfolio, with criteria set as volunteering hours in previous 2 years and availability for the current year. As soon as the new Board was set up, from the applicants, the extended board team and Kochi Branch Council members for 2023 were confirmed. In addition to the specified Tier4 volunteers, additional volunteers were also recruited for specific program support through VEP or through direct email requests. The **volunteering opportunities were diverse**, catering to academic outreach, social outreach, academic and professional mentorship, social media and marketing, Narrators / Reviewers in English / Malayalam for Audio Books compilation for Kerala Blind Federation, event-specific volunteer opportunities for WAVES 2023, CXO Meet, WINGS2023, speakers for the joint WhizTalks with PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter, etc. A comprehensive **volunteer onboarding training** programme was used to onboard all volunteers.

Some of our members have also taken up Global / South Asia Regional volunteering positions. The Youth and Social Impact Coordinator could lead many academic outreach initiatives to empower youth with skills training and social good initiatives in alignment with PMImpact and PMI 4.0 Global strategies. Some of the South Asia Region initiatives supported by our volunteers include Social Media Task Force, Women Empowerment Committee and Project Librarian. The monthly member induction program and Smartference events also helped us onboard many interested new members as volunteers with specific training sessions.

Volunteer Recognition Programmes was yet another success factor for the motivation of our passionate volunteers. After every program, volunteers were recognised with volunteer certificates and on social media. Further, volunteer feedback was invited post an event / program and these were considered suitably for the chapter to improve its volunteer engagement approach. Volunteer effort tracking for each activity was effectively done using a smartsheet developed for volunteers to submit their voluntary work and have it approved by the respective Vice Presidents in charge of the programs. An in person Volunteer Meet was held at SP Grand Days, Thiruvananthapuram on 06 Jan 2024 where the chapter leaders and the extended board as a team reviewed activities so far and plans for the year 2024.

One program that stands out as the strongest and exemplifies volunteer engagement, recruitment, and retention in the PMI Kerala Chapter is the "Mentorship for Excellence" initiative. By leveraging the vast network of senior professionals within the PMI Kerala Chapter, the program ensures a diverse pool of mentors with varied backgrounds and experiences. The program goes beyond mere mentor-mentee relationships and emphasizes the importance of a supportive community through networking events, workshops, and seminars. By connecting experienced professionals with aspiring project managers, the program creates a thriving ecosystem of learning and growth, knowledge sharing, skill development, and community building. Its comprehensive approach ensures that volunteers are actively engaged, recruited effectively, and retained in the chapter, ultimately contributing to overall success of the project management community associated with Kerala Chapter.

In FY 2023-24, the chapter offered a total of 50 volunteer opportunities, and 103 applications were received in response to those openings. 35 individuals were given volunteer roles after rigorous assessment, interviews. ## Academic Outreach

## PMI Kerala Chapter Student Clubs - inaugural in SA Region

Considering the success of the Academic Outreach program of the PMI Kerala Chapter, PMI from Global level discussed with the South Asia Chapter Engagement team and piloted launch of the PMI Student Membership Program with the chapter. The PMI Student Membership was offered at a



special price for students to become PMI members. The heavily discounted price of US\$12 plus taxes from the usual US\$32 plus taxes, was valid for one-year membership to PMI and the PMI Trivandrum, Kerala Chapter. As part of the membership benefits, students were given access to all resources at PMI as well as exclusive access to webinars, certification offers, and a huge network of project professionals across the world. PMI Kerala has set the record for the maximum number of PMI Student Memberships, all of which are initiated and fostered by our multiple academic forums.

Following the rise in PMI Student Memberships at the colleges, chapter received approval to official name them as PMI Kerala Chapter Student Clubs at the respective colleges. The first PMI Kerala Chapter Student Club was inaugurated at Saintgits College of Engineering with 84 PMI Student Members. Their official logo was released during WINGS 2023 held at their campus. The second PMI Kerala Chapter Student Club was formed at CUSAT with 82 PMI Student Members and third PMI Kerala Chapter Student Club at Digital University of Kerala with 25 PMI Student Members. Thus, PMI Kerala Chapter has once again made the pioneering step for the PMI Student Memberships and PMI Student Clubs. Board wishes to place on record the efforts of Past President Jayakishore S R and VP Finance Hariprasad P S for their perseverance for PMI Global acceptance and constant motivation to the students to make this a reality.

## **PMI Kerala Chapter Academic Forums**

Our commitment to nurturing the next generation of project management professionals is exemplified by the signing of Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) with major universities in Kerala. These partnerships aim to establish student clubs / academic forums, fostering learning, and collaboration among future project management leaders. In FY 2023-24, the Academic Outreach reached an all time high of 550 students from professional and business schools in Kerala!

## Internships

PMI Kerala Chapter in association with Kerala Knowledge Economy Mission (KKEM) conducted an internship drive for 4 companies. A total of 108 students were offered 60 days unpaid Internship during the period June - August 2023 at company locations in Trivandrum/Kochi in Kerala . This is the first opportunity created following the signing of MoU by PMI Kerala Chapter with KKEM. For the first time, Kerala Chapter also offered internship opportunities to support the respective VP and extended board team in the Professional Development and Outreach portfolios in the Chapter.

## **Diverse Collaborations**
