

Academic excellence Awards for Student Club Partners

Project Management Institute Kerala invites nominations for the prestigious Academic excellence awards in Students and Faculty categories.

Award Eligibility:

Best Student Project Award Nominee **must have at least 2 members from PMIK Student Club** [Individual (in which case, must be a member) or max group of three can apply]

Faculty Award nominee **must be from PMIK Student Club institutions.**

Nomination Criteria

1. Best Student Project Award:

- a) Nominated project should follow Project Management framework.
- b) Project should have a clear business case and deliverables.
- c) Project quality should be defined using triple constraints.
- d) Project should be drafted in such a way to show what all activities were completed in each phase of the project.
- e) Nomination should be submitted with a write up limited to 500 words on project execution details and methodology
- f) Name (individual /team), semester, course and institution name must be clearly mentioned.

2. Faculty Award for developing Innovative teaching methods:

- a) What was the objective & scope? (e.g., Who was involved? What kind of change did this entail?)
- b) What teaching or learning challenge was addressed by this project?
- c) How was it executed/tested?
- d) How was the project innovative?
- e) How was the project evaluated? What data are (or will be) available to describe the effects on learning?
- f) How could this project be adapted to meet different learning outcomes and/or be transferred to another institution?
- g) Nomination should be submitted with a write up limited to 500 words
- h) Faculty name, designation, department, and institution name must be clearly mentioned.
